Dear Visitor

We are looking forward to welcoming you to Royal High School Bath for your forthcoming visit, and it is important that we take this opportunity to explain our expectations of you.

As you will understand, the health and wellbeing of all our staff, students, visitors and contractors is of paramount importance. The most recent Government guidelines can be found here [COVID-19 Response: Living with COVID-19 - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](https://www.gov.uk/government/guidance/covid-19-response-living-with-covid-19).

The latest guidelines mean that we are no longer required to ask staff, students or visitors to take Lateral Flow Tests (LFTs) twice weekly or prior to visiting the School. However, we do ask that you adhere to the following steps to ensure our community stays healthy:

- Please do not attend either School site if you are feeling unwell.
- Our policy remains that you should not attend School until 24 hours after a fever has subsided and 48 hours after a stomach bug symptoms have stopped.
- If someone in your household has Covid-19 or is showing symptoms we ask you not to come to the site.
- If you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 6 days then please wear a face covering whilst on site.

In addition to the above requirements, we ask that if you have tested positive for Covid-19 then follow these guidelines to understand at what point we would be happy to welcome you to the School.

- Day 0 is the day of your first symptom or the day that you took your positive test.
- You should then test on day 5 and 6 (24 hours apart).
- You may visit school as soon as you receive your second negative test (24 hours apart).
- If you receive a positive result on day 5 you should continue to test every day until you receive two negative test results 24 hours apart.
- If you continue to test positive past day 10 you would be able to return to school on day 11 assuming you feel well enough to do so.

Whilst no longer a legal requirement, face coverings may be worn by students, visitors and staff. We may require you to wear a face covering if we are concerned about the number of positive cases in the local community. If you are exempt from wearing a face covering this will of course, be respected. Please continue to sanitise your hands regularly and as you travel around the site.

A member of our staff will sign you into the building and your host will meet you in reception.
